10. Checks needle and catheter for defects	1		
11. Stabilizes vein	1		
12. Aligns catheter parallel to the vein and performs venipuncture with catheter aimed toward the sholder.	1		
13. Observes flashback	1		
14. Advances needle/catheter	1		
15. Advances catheter	1		
16. Withdraws needle	1		
17. Stabilizes catheter until secured with tape	1		
18. Quickly connects IV administration set not allowing air into the catheter	1		
19. Begins IV flow by opening clamp and assuring flow	1		
20. Examines site for infiltration (must verbalize)	1		
21. Adjusts clamp for KVO	1		
22. Applies antibiotic ointment to site	1		
23. Secures catheter and tubing with tape or bio-occlusive	1
