	Points		Comments
10. Using a rotating/boring motion and directing the needle 60 degrees distally advances the needle through the bone	1		
11. Confirms placement in the marrow by removing stylet, attaching a syringe and aspirating blood and bone marrow	1*		
12. Attaches syringe with sterile saline and flushes - observes easy ability to flush and looks for signs of infiltration	1		
13. Attaches IV administration set	1		
14. Secures tubing with tape	1		
15. Secures the bone marrow needle just as any other impaled object	1		
16. Maintains aseptic technique	1		
17. Labels site, tubing and IV solution bag appropriately.	1		
18. Rechecks flow rate	1
