10. Holds ET with the tip pointing down and advances the tube into the nostril advancing it straight back - a back and forth rotary motion can be used to overcome resistance	1		
11. Continues to advance the tube to the larynx (approx. 5-7 inches)	1		
12. Listens to the proximal end of the tube for breath sounds as the tip of the tube approaches the larynx	1		
13. Listening to the breath sounds, guides the tube to the vocal cords and on inspiration pushes the tube into place	1		
14. Inflates cuff with 5-10 cc of air prior to auscultating lung fields	1		
15. Begins ventilations with BVM	1		
16. Checks tube placement by auscultating left and right lung fields, epigastrium & by observing chest rise	1*		
17. Confirms tube placement by using an esophageal detector device (EDD)	1		
18. Secures endotracheal tube with tape or ties	1		
19. Re-verifies endotracheal tube placement as in steps 15 and 16	1
