P.E.O. INTERNATIONAL PEACE SCHOLARSHIP FOR WOMEN GRADUATE STUDENTS

Believing that education is fundamental to world peace and understanding, the P.E.O. Sisterhood contributes scholarship funds for women from other countries to study in the U.S. and Canada.

The women must pursue graduate degrees, have a full year of course work remaining, and submit a witnessed statement certifying that they will return to their home countries within 60 days of completing their degrees. The maximum amount of the award is \$10,000 annually.

Interested women must apply for eligibility by December 15, 2011. If eligible, they must submit their applications by January 31, 2012. Eligibility forms are available at www.peointernational.org. (Click on "P.E.O. Projects/Philanthropies" and scroll down to "P.E.O. International Peace Scholarship".)
