

Join ISSS for a guided hike of
Griffis Sculpture Park



This 1.72 km² outdoor art museum was created by artist Larry W. Griffis Jr. in 1966. The first sculpture park in the United States, it features more than 250 works of art created by over 100 artists. Its 16 km of trails also serve as a nature preserve. The idea for the museum came to Griffis while he was touring Italy with his family. While watching his children play on the ruins of Emperor Hadrian's villa, Griffis realized the value of interactive art.
