

Join ISSS for a day of
**High Ropes Courses and
Alpine Sliding!**



High outdoor adventure! The high ropes course is a series of platforms and “bridges” built in 16,000 m² of forest. There are platforms in trees and bridges connect the platforms. The challenge is to figure out how to get across to the next platform. The 8 courses have different levels of difficulty and the more difficult the course, the higher up it is in the trees. All courses have at least one zip line and some have several. The alpine slide is similar to a roller coaster. You ride in a “car” which is attached to rails that follow a zig- zagging spiral path down the mountain. You control the speed with brakes on the car.

The track is 1500 meters long with a vertical drop of 86 meters.
