A Guided Boat Tour of the Erie Canal Locks at Lockport and Wine Tasting



Join ISSS as we get a special personalized guided tour of a fascinating part of New York State's history: The Erie Canal. Much remains the same on the Erie Canal today as it was in the 1800's. Hand-dug to connect the Hudson River with the Niagara River, the 584 km Erie Canal is truly a great engineering feat. Originally, 83 stone locks overcame the 174-meter difference in the level between the rivers. Enlarged in the early 1900's, now 35 locks allow larger vessels to travel across New York State. After that tour, we will visit two wineries in the Niagara Wine Region to sample the wines they produce.
