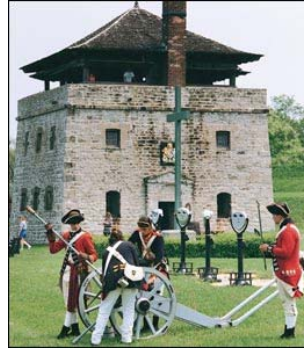


Join ISSS for
A Guided Tour of Historic Old Fort Niagara



Join ISSS for a guided tour of Old Fort Niagara, a fort built by the French in 1726. The British Army gained control of the fort in 1759 during the French & Indian War. The events of that war will be re-created as part of a special encampment weekend, complete with a cannon barrage & assault of the fort by British soldiers. The fort has been occupied by three nations: France, Great Britain, and the U.S.
