Anne P. Brody Scholarship

The *Anne P. Brody Scholarship* was made possible by an endowment established by friends, colleagues and family members of Anne and Harold Brody. Anne came to Buffalo in 1954 with her husband, Harold, who served as Chairman of the Anatomy Department from 1971 until 1992.

Among many other achievements in the Buffalo community, Anne was instrumental in the creation of the UB Women's Club's International and University & Community Service committees. Following her death in April, 2000, Anne Brody was selected from among hundreds of nominees as one of the 100 "historically important women of the 20th Century in Western New York" to be honored by having her name engraved on a one foot square stone in the "Bricks for Buffalo Women's Walkway" near Buffalo's waterfront.

The UB Women's Club joins the Brody family in offering this annual scholarship to continue and to honor Anne Brody's commitment to assist UB students and faculty in need. In honor of Mrs. Brody's commitment to students, all students who demonstrate outstanding achievement and/or exceptional promise are encouraged to apply. The Brody family has requested that a special effort be made to publicize the existence of the endowment to international students.

Eligibility Criteria

- Completion of one academic year prior to receipt of the award
- Enrollment in UB during the period covered by the scholarship (2007-2008)
- Eligible students include those who are pursuing an undergraduate degree in any course of study at the University at Buffalo
- All undergraduate students are encouraged to apply, however, preference will be given to those students whose applications clearly demonstrate that the student has maintained outstanding achievement with a history of service to the university and the community.
