AAUW applauds community organizations and programs that support our mission. We encourage you to apply for a grant for up to the maximum award of \$1,500. Please provide the following information (in the order listed) as it pertains to your organization. A maximum of three (3) typewritten or computer generated pages should address the information required in Part A. In addition please attach the documents as required in Part B and complete the enclosed Cover Page with your application package. Grant awardees will be required to complete a Grant Agreement/Assurances form.

High School Background and Program Information (max. 3 pages) - Briefly describe your school – include type (co-ed, male or female), population, setting (urban, suburban, rural)
