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On **Tuesday, February 7, 2012**, GMP will be administering the **2011 AMC-10A** to students in GMP-3 and 4 and the **AMC-12A** to students in GMP-5 and 6 who have signed up to take it. We encourage our students to take this contest at their homeschool, but we also hold it here for those whose schools do not participate.

The test contains 25 multiple-choice questions. Participants have 75 minutes to complete the test. We will provide #2 pencils and scrap paper. Calculators are NOT permitted. **Students should bring a ruler, compass, and protractor.**

Students who are in the top 5% of all participants or score at least 100 points on the AMC 12 (or those who are in the top 1% in the AMC 10) are invited to participate in the American Invitational Mathematics Examination (AIME).

Awards are given to the students with the highest score in each school. We are considered a “school.” Everyone who participates will receive a certificate of participation.
