

INFECTION CONTROL CERTIFICATION: All residents & fellows beginning training at the University of Buffalo must complete a New York State approved infection control course prior to orientation.

- You must complete the course and print the course completion certificate prior to orientation.
- Forward your completion certificate to your program coordinator by June 2nd. Upon receipt of the certificate, your program office will mark this portion of your on-line tutorial as complete.

If you graduated from a New York State medical school after May of 2006, you are automatically credited with having completed this requirement as part of your coursework. This certification is valid for four years from the date of your graduation.
