

BRING WITH YOU ON YOUR FIRST DAY OF ORIENTATION...



ALL INCOMING RESIDENTS:

- Copies of any health records or tests you think are important; and a copy of the health history form if it has not already been provided.
- Names (including correct spelling), social security numbers and dates of birth for spouse and children.
- Loan deferrals or verifications of employment to be completed for lenders, mortgage companies, student loan companies, etc.
- Cash (\$1,500 USD or more) for apartment deposit, groceries, living expenses, transportation, etc.
- Local address and phone number.
- A copy of your current health insurance enrollment card.

NON-US CITIZENS:

- Your permanent resident card or work authorization.
- If you are here on a visa - bring your passport, stamped I-94, and visa approval letter.

IF YOU WILL BE A VETERANS ADMINISTRATION WESTERN NEW YORK HEALTH CARE SYSTEM (VAWNYHS) EMPLOYEE:

- \$75.00 if interested in purchasing group Long Term Disability Insurance through University Medical Resident Services (UMRS).
 - This is the same plan offered to residents employed by UMRS and provides guaranteed conversion upon graduation.
 - The annual premium is \$75.00 and the first year premium is due on the first day of orientation.
