Note that students may engage in research for academic credit, as a volunteer, for a salary/stipend, or as a work study experience (if eligible to do so). Investigators can specify the minimum requirements in terms of student skills, completed coursework, and class standing. They are also asked to briefly describe the research project and to specify the semester(s)/dates of the research opportunity.
